## **MINUTES**

Call to order

Following a brief presentation and summary from Nancy Morris, legal counsel for the housing authority, regarding the sole item on the agenda, Ms. Morris recommended a motion as follows:

RESOLVED and moved to rescind the action from the special meeting of December 21, 2020, and direct that Fargo Housing policy be followed with respect to the matters that were raised at that meeting.

Upon inquiry from Commissioner Jefferson for some additional details, counsel explained that there was some question about what was presented to the board at that meeting, since there are no agenda, minutes or other recording of the meeting, and since it is clear that the housing authority policies and process were not followed, given that some outside entity brought forward an issue for the board's consideration, counsel – following her review of what is known about the proceeding – recommended that the motion is appropriate. Mr. Pike explained that it is possible that some of the matters might come up at a subsequent meeting.
